Cleaning

The cleaning and preparation service of the house before your arrival is included in the price of your reservation. If you need any extra cleaning, do not hesitate to contact us, they can have it for an additional cost.

It is absolutely forbidden to access glass containers or bottles anywhere around the pool.
Before bathing it is mandatory to shower
Large inflatables are not allowed in the pool
It is forbidden to dive headfirst into the water
All minors must use the pool under adult supervision.

Air conditioner

We strongly recommend that you act in favor of the environment and take government recommendations into account. It is of fundamental importance to keep doors and windows closed while using the air conditioning and to keep the temperature in a range between 21° and 22° degrees Celsius.



Arrival

Your accommodation will be available from 4:00 p.m. on the day of your arrival until 8:00 p.m. All arrivals between 8:00 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. are subject to availability and imply an additional cost of €24.20.

All arrivals after 24:00 are subject to availability and suppose an additional supplement of €48.40

If when accessing the property, you notice something different than usual, please inform us upon arrival, otherwise you will be held responsible for the damage caused.

Departures

The Accommodations must be vacated the same day of departure before 11:00 a.m. If you want to leave later, please contact us and depending on availability we can offer you an option.

We ask that before your departure, make sure that the windows are properly closed and that both the air conditioning and the lights and other appliances are turned off. Please leave the keys on the table and close the door on your way out.

Remember to throw the garbage in the designated containers

Noises

We remind you that your accommodation is located in a private urbanization whose community of neighbors establishes rules that must be respected. Therefore, we remind you that between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. you must avoid annoying noises including loud TV, music on the terraces, moving furniture or other heavy objects, knocking on doors, and communicating with an inappropriate tone of voice

Laundry

We remind you that it is absolutely forbidden to hang bathing suits, towels, bedding and clothing from the balconies/terraces. For drying clothes, you have a clothesline.

Trash

We ask that, as far as possible, you recycle waste by depositing it in the designated containers acting in favor of the environment.

Gardens and Common Areas

It is forbidden to carry out activities such as: Skateboarding, roller skating, Rollerblading, Cycling, playing ball, driving mopeds, electric scooters or any activity that may cause damage to of the neighboring community.



We discover Marbella:

A wonderful Andalusian city, located in the south of Spain and located in the heart of the Costa del Sol, whose Old Town offers its visitors a typical Andalusian flavor. Sea and mountains, tradition and modernity come together in this Mediterranean city to offer visitors an environment rich in nuances, multicultural and cosmopolitan, open to progress and a way of life based on coexistence and the welcoming nature of its people.

Its origin dates back to Roman times, from which there are abundant archaeological remains; In the same way, from the Arab period it preserves two towers and the walls of the Castle; from Christian times, in the old town, it preserves the Church of the Incarnation, the House of the Corregidor and the Hospital of San Juan de Dios.

The historic part of the city, located in a beautiful bay, shelters beautiful corners with a typical Andalusian flavor, with whitewashed houses and orange trees that adorn the streets and squares. An ideal setting to taste any of the succulent recipes of the local gastronomy.

In the municipality of Marbella we find two main population centers: Marbella and San Pedro Alcántara.

The rest of the population is dispersed in a multitude of urbanizations, highlighting Nueva Andalucía and Las Chapas as large residential areas. Marbella stands out for its privileged climate, internationally recognized. The average annual temperature oscillates around 18.5º C, with 320 sunny days per year.

The weather seasons do not cause major changes and the rains in our municipality do not usually exceed 50 days a year, with the months of December and January being the months with the highest rainfall.

This climate is due to a unique geographical situation, in which the mountains that protect Marbella, "Sierra Blanca" with its peak called La Concha, visible from the entire municipality, together with the inlet configuration of its coast, act as a shelter for the city of the north winds and making it enjoy a special microclimate, unique in the world, and which becomes one of its greatest tourist attractions.

About our accommodation...

This apartment is located in Marbella, 50 meters from Real de Zaragoza Beach and 11 km from Marbella Bullring, and offers a bar, a private beach area and a casino.

Set in a 5-pool complex, Romana Playa offers panoramic sea views and a private terrace

Marbella is the second largest city on the Costa del Sol with 148,000 inhabitants. In its old town we can highlight the Museum of Engraving, declared an Asset of Cultural Interest, the beautiful Church of La Encarnación, located a few meters from the walls of the Castle and the popular Plaza de los Naranjos. A beautiful and cheerful place full of shops, restaurants and terraces with a fabulous atmosphere to discover both day and night. It is also worth mentioning the Parque de la Alameda, in the city center a few meters from the Paseo Marítimo.

Marbella has 27 km of coastline divided into 24 beautiful beaches that are characterized by their long strips of fine sand and calm waters.

We can find very diverse beaches; from long dunes such as Playa Real de Zaragoza, to central beaches with good facilities such as Playa de Venus and, of course, there are also beaches with luxurious beach bars where you can enjoy the Marbella sun such as Playa del Cable.
